How to Play

Please note: There are set-up directions and suggestions for use located throughout this file to make it easier.

- Students work independently or in a pair/group. They read a sentence from their sentence sheet. They look around the room to find a word that best completes the sentence. When they find the word they think is the best, they write the answer on their recording sheet in the big box. In the little box next to the answer, they write the number or letter that corresponds with that answer.
- The letter number that is recorded on the recording sheet is the breakout code.
- EXAMPLE: The answer to number 1 is "excited" and the word that shows the best fit for the sentence is "excited." (The answer key shows "1" in the little box next to "excited.")
- Students continue this step until they have recorded the answer key for all numbers and letters of the breakout code.
